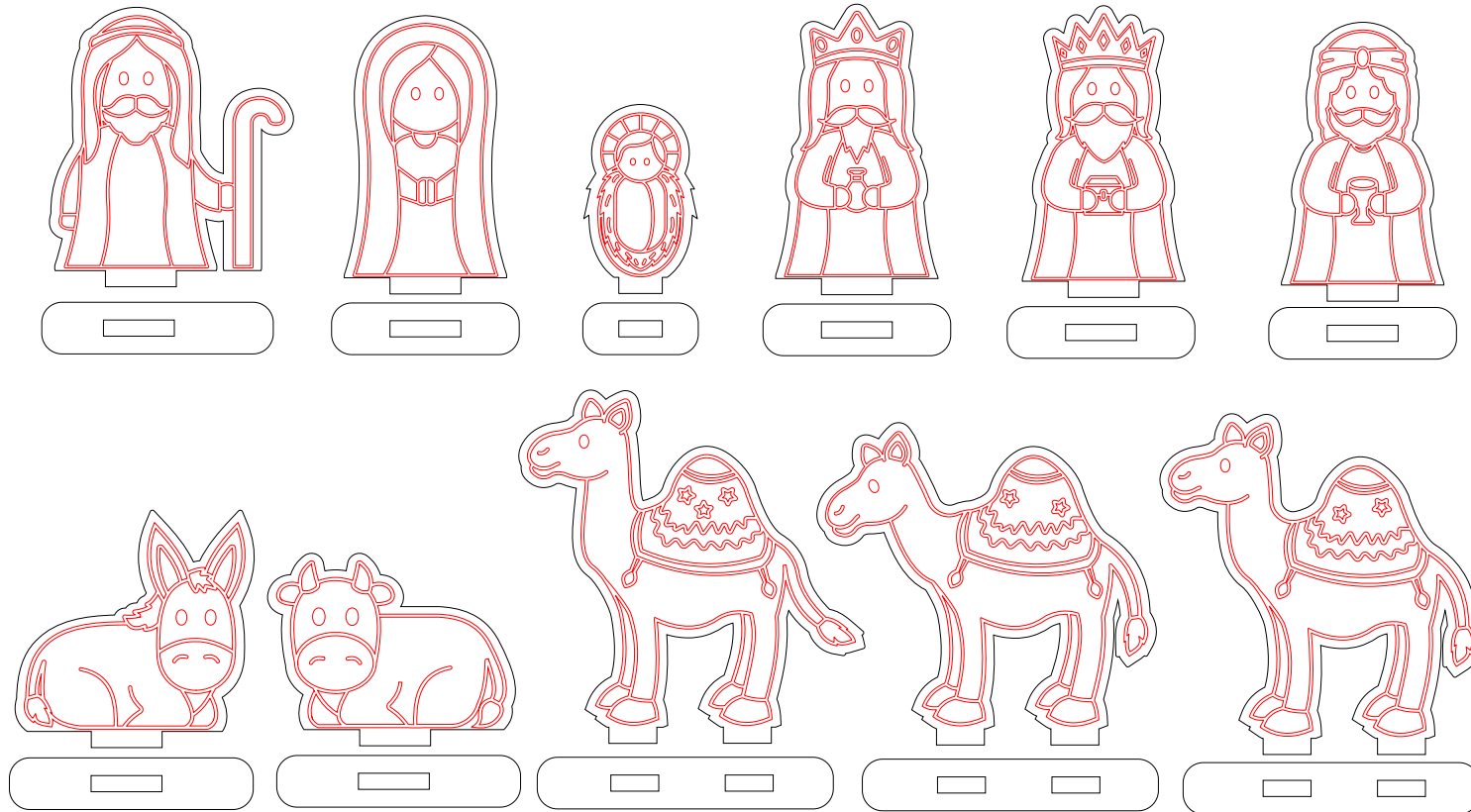

These sets have been designed to fit together with tension, however, you can add a little glue on the tabs as you assemble. If you choose to glue this together, we recommend painting the set prior to gluing.



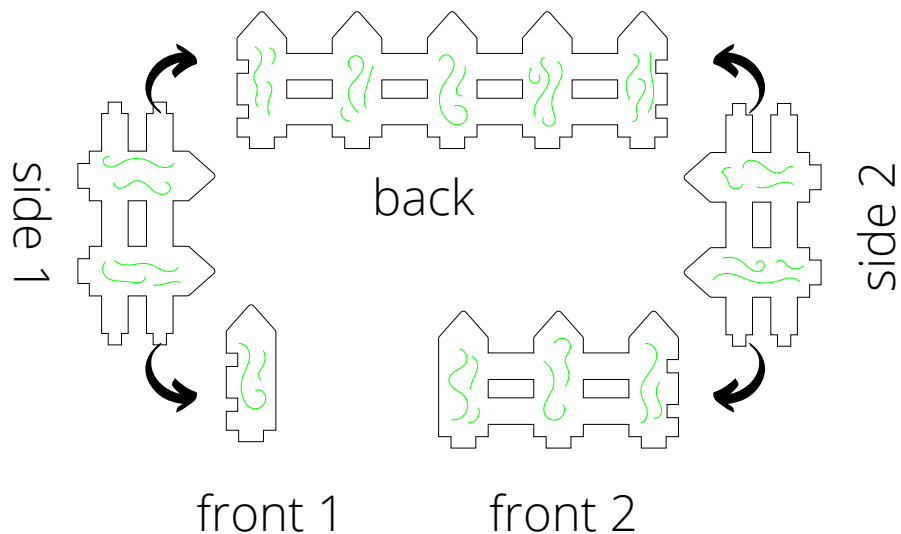
Characters are packaged with their bases. The wise men, Mary, Joseph, the donkey, and the cow all have the same base. Jesus has a tiny one, and the camels have a longer base with two notches.

Please note: because of the way the laser cuts, one side of the base has a narrower notch opening than the other. If you are struggling to fit the character into its base, try flipping the base over.

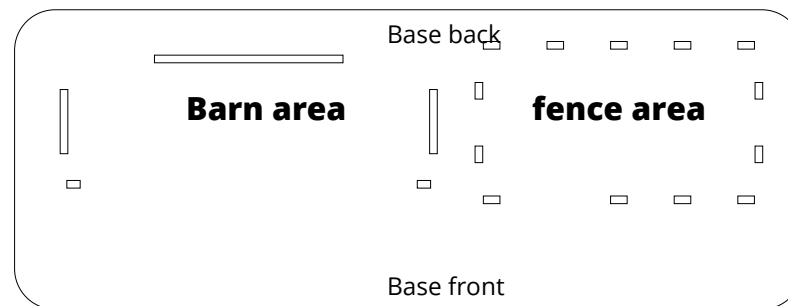
Fence Assembly

Assemble the fence first

(it is difficult to fit it in the base if you build the barn before the fence).
The more deeply engraved side of the fence pieces face out.



Base

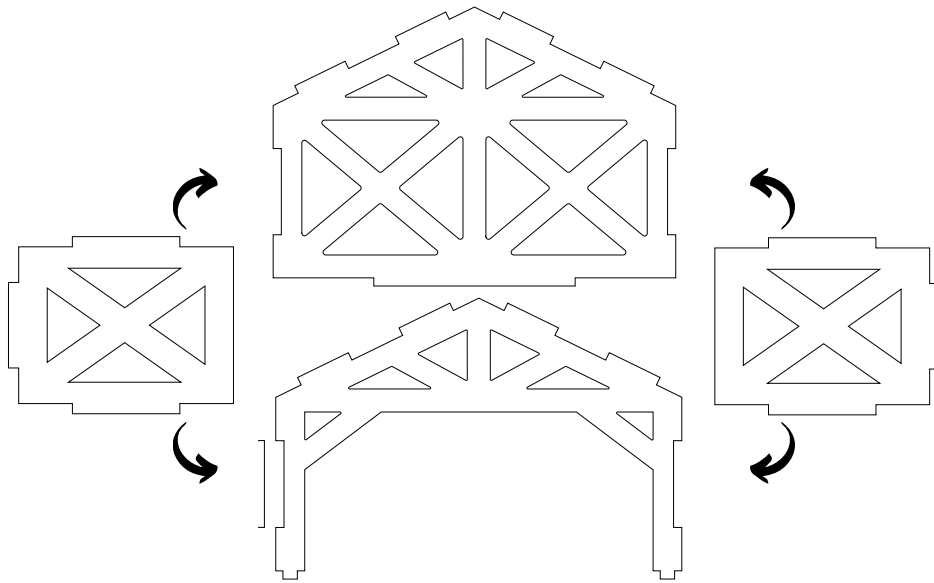


The fence should sit to the right of the barn. Because of the way that the laser cuts, it will not fit if the base is flipped over.

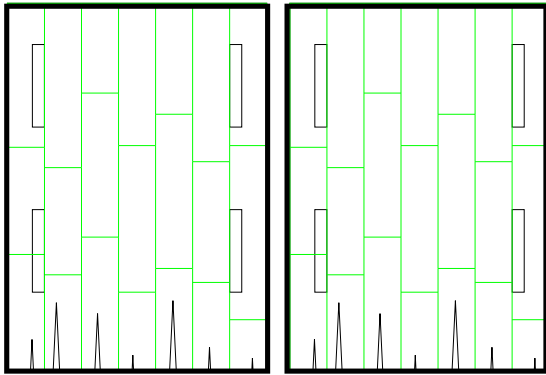
Start by attaching the two sides to the back by fitting the tabs on the sides into the notches on the back. Then attach the two front pieces to the coordinating sides.

When the fence is constructed, you can then fit it into the base.

Barn Assembly



Attach the sides to the front and back, with the flat side up and the tab side down. Once the walls are constructed, Attach the roof tiles with the patterned side up. When the barn is constructed, you can then fit it into the base.



The short flat side of the roof tiles should meet to form the center of the roof.

Base



The barn should sit to the left of the the fence.
